

NOTICE OF POLL AND SITUATION OF POLLING STATIONS

Referendum on the Neighbourhood Plan for Daws Hill

1. A referendum will be held on Thursday 14 November 2019 to decide on the question below:

Do you want Wycombe District Council to use the **Neighbourhood Plan for Daws Hill** to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

2. The hours of poll will be from **7am** to **10pm**.
3. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Queen Victoria Road, High Wycombe, Bucks, HP11 1BB by **5pm Thursday 14 November 2019**.
4. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5pm Wednesday 6 November 2019**.
5. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5pm Wednesday 6 November 2019**.
