

WYCOMBE DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2019

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Wycombe District Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (and all other enabling powers). The effect of the Order will be to regulate the use and set the charges to be made at the Council's off street car parks.

The proposals incorporated in the draft Order and the reasons for the proposals are set out in the table below:

Proposal	Reason
To vary the means of payment of charges to one or more of: 1) cash, 2) payment card or 3) mobile phone payment.	To ensure long-term viability of the off-street parking service and maintain flexibility in the Council's parking offer.
To vary and increase the charges.	To ensure the long-term viability of the Council's car parking functions.
To make other minor amendments to the 2017 Order and consolidate the 2018 Order	For ease of understanding of the articles contained therein

The proposed Order will revoke the existing Wycombe District Council (Off-Street) Parking Places Order 2017 and Wycombe District Council Desborough Street (Off-Street) Parking Places Order 2018 and all previous Orders.
