

WYCOMBE DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION) ORDER 2020

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wycombe District Council (“the Council”) propose to make an Order under Section 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the Wycombe District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (“the Off Street Order 2019”).

2. The effect of the proposed Order is to:

(a) add the following car parks to Schedule 1 of the Wycombe District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (“the Off Street Order 2019”) to reflect the rules pertaining to those locations:
