

Community Cop Cards sticker information:

Cyber Safety

Purpose - This sticker is designed to promote awareness of the risks online. It creates discussion around unreliable and extreme content whilst helping to improve a child's safety online.

Approach – The 'Trust Me' resource has been created by Childnet with teachers in mind after feedback that a resource was needed to start conversations around extremism and extreme online content and to provoke thought about inaccurate and pervasive information that they might come across online.

Developed in partnership with the London Grid for Learning (LGfL) Safeguarding Board, the resource contains lesson plans that aim to empower educators to discuss how to think critically around the areas of content, contact, and propaganda material that may seek to persuade or change their views. Throughout these lessons children will learn to think whether they can trust what they are seeing or hearing, how to check if someone or something is trustworthy and give them more confidence to voice their concerns or questions to adults.

Tasks to complete to receive the sticker- The class will need to have completed at least one lesson based on "Trust Me" in order to obtain a sticker. Alternatively, the class has the option of a workshop delivered by a Child Exploitation and Online Protection (CEOP) trainer from Bucks County Council.
