

Community Cop Cards sticker information:

Environment

Purpose- This sticker is all about getting the children to connect with their local environment whilst learning about its diversity and fragility and how they can help to preserve it for the future.

Approach- The Best Kept Village award scheme runs from April to June so the classes will be arranging to go out and pick litter and tidy villages within their local Parishes. As this project is funded by the local Parish Councils in part we wanted the children to get back out into these Parishes and do some work in the outdoors around conservation or the environment. This is all part of the process of trying to further create a sense of social responsibility for the children within their communities.

Tasks to complete to receive the sticker- The class will need to have completed a litter picking session in their local Parish or a project of their own making within the class.

Resources to use- Teacher's will organise this with the local Neighbourhood Policing Team.
