

Community Cop Cards sticker information:

Local History

Purpose- This sticker is all about encouraging the children to explore and investigate their local area and history.

Approach- The Marlow and South West rural schools are located in a wonderful part of Buckinghamshire with a diverse and interesting history, as well as being situated in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Through encouraging the children to learn about their communities and take more interest in them we hope to impart a sense of social responsibility and ultimately reduce the likelihood of them committing anti-social behaviour in the future.

Tasks to complete to receive the sticker- The children should visit a place a local place of historical interest and whilst they are there take two photographs:

- An artistic shot of the museum, bridge, mill etc
- A “selfie” to show they were there.

Children will need to print these pictures off at home or school and then add them to their packs. Please make sure their names and schools are on each photo.

At the end of the scheme, when the packs are collected and stickers counted we will also be holding a competition to see who took the best picture. Judging of the best picture prize will be carried out by the Marlow Neighbourhood Policing Team and the winner will receive an individual prize.
