ORDER

UPON THE COURT having considered the Claimant's application submitted by E-Filing on 9th April 2020 requesting an adjournment;

AND UPON THE COURT being aware that the hearing of the Claimant's Application for a Final Injunction is due to be heard on 22 April 2020;

AND UPON THE COURT reading the Witness Statement of Ms. Kiran Khanna dated 9th April 2020;

AND UPON THE COURT being aware of the ongoing National Health Emergency and the restrictions placed on travel and attendance at public places;

AND UPON THE COURT noting that the London Gypsies and Travellers Group were contacted on 25th March 2020 with a view to them consenting to the adjournment but that they have not responded within 14 days to the request to do so

IT IS ORDERED

1. The name of the Claimant be substituted hereafter for Buckinghamshire Council.
2. The final hearing of this claim, listed for 22nd April 2020, shall be adjourned until to the first open date after 30th September 2020, with a time estimate 2 hours.
3. In the event that the restrictions on movement have not been removed by the 30th September 2020, the Claimant has permission to write to the Court to request a further adjournment of the final hearing in this matter, if so required.
4. The Interim Injunction Order of Mr. Justice Miller sealed and dated 7th August 2019 shall remain in force until the final hearing of this claim, or further order.
5. Service of this Order be dispensed with at this stage, save that as soon as possible a copy of this Order be placed on the Claimant's website and sent by e-mail to the London Gypsies and Travellers Group. Once it is practicable to do so, when the restrictions imposed by the Emergency have been lifted a copy of the Order shall be served in accordance with the provisions set out in paragraph 6.
6. The Claimant will serve a copy of this Order in a transparent waterproof envelope or laminated copy in the prominent position at each of the entrances to the Land identified on the Maps and listed on the schedule attached to the original Order dated 7th August 2019.
7. No order as to costs
