

Wycombe District Council Annual Parking Report 2018 to 2019

1. Introduction

This report is produced in accordance with section 55 of the Road Traffic Act 1984, as amended by the Traffic Management Act 2004 (TMA), and also meets with the requirements of the Local Government Act 2015.

2. Background

Wycombe District Council (WDC) are responsible for our off-street car parks. Buckinghamshire County Council have been responsible for on-street parking since 22 March 2012 and merged all of the districts to be enforced by an external agency.

WDC are responsible for the operation of 11 car parks in High Wycombe, 7 in Marlow, 2 in Princes Risborough and 1 in Bourne End, comprising of a total of over 3000 spaces. The car parks are operated under the legislation set out in the Traffic Management Act 2004.
