

Legacy Wycombe District Council Annual Parking Report 2019 to 2020

1. Introduction

This report is produced in accordance with section 55 of the Road Traffic Act 1984, as amended by the Traffic Management Act 2004 (TMA), and also meets with the requirements of the Local Government Act 2015.

2. Background

The legacy Wycombe District Council (WDC) was responsible for off-street parking. The legacy Buckinghamshire County Council was responsible for on-street parking.

Operationally the legacy WDC Parking Service was responsible for 26 car parks; 1 in Bourne End, 1 in Hazlemere, 12 in Wycombe, 1 in Handleton Common, 8 in Marlow, 2 in Princess Risborough, and 1 in Wooburn; comprising 3152 car parking spaces. Enforcement of the car park restrictions was in accordance with the Traffic Management Act 2004.
