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Dear Siri/Madam

I would request that construction traffic does not use the country lanes around Marsh to Owlswick via Hunt Kennels. The road surfaces have already broken up and are subsiding, We already get very large trucks going down the lanes - some from a business past the hunt kennels. For our lanes such large and heavy trucks is not acceptable. The lanes are used a great deal for leisure purposes - cycling, walking and dog walking and horse riding and it puts many people potential danger. The lanes do not have any street lights or foot paths.

Land off Kimblewick Road (Ref: No.14)

Great consideration should be given to the run off water created by the development. The only way for it to run is down the ditches along Kimblewick Road towards the Junction near the lane to Marsh Farm. The fields behind the proposed development drain this way and until recently a large volume of water could be seen flowing across and down the roads. The Culvert at the bottom by the Tee junction from the Prince of Wales Pub should be checked to make sure it can cope with the additional Volume of water. It connects the ditches that run the length of Kimblewick Road on both sides and the ditches running from the fields behind the Willows and Hawthorns Bungalows.. See attachment
