Also we have a view of the hills & fields and this would be lost if houses were built on the land. The land is also very marshy & wet behind our road & this causes concern if any development were to be built.

It appears that the majority of the houses are to be built at the end of the village. This is not an even distribution and yet no properties are to be built in Marsh despite being part of the neighbourhood plan. There is no provision for a doctors surgery to cope with the extra families & the school does not have enough places to cope with the extra demand too.
