

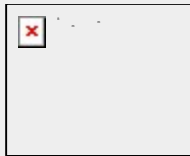

**Comments:**

In 2018 there was 2000 tons of human waste dumped into said site, which is 50 meters from my bungalow, it was left there for months then spread on top, making this a bog marsh. In September 2018 snow was on the ground

a third of the human waste came round my bungalow and down the road and flooded me, due to the consolidation of the waste not allowing the water to go through the ground I personally made fifty phone calls to Wycombe Environmental Department for two months on and off with no response or visits.. In 2019 I have now got major cracks in the face side of my bungalow, it has lifted my footings I have had one quote of £50,000, to sort this out. When it was farmed, ploughed and planted there was no flooding at all this is a run off area from the Chiltern Hills, and was a run off area and was absorbed into the ploughed field, causing no flooding at all when ploughed. In January 2020 I have had more extensive flooding due to the field being left a bog, which also flooded the Kimblewick Road, and closed the road, talk to Buckinghamshire Council to confirm. Managed properly as said in your report this is the best and most versatile agricultural land, and it is a valuable resource. I used to own the strip up the side of the road for twenty five years, I know for definite there are hedgehogs, grass snakes, weasels, and fruit bats, which I have seen over the years. I would like to point out, it is a criminal offence to kill or endanger their lives. And housing will definitely cause flooding to me and my neighbours.
