Subject: Great and Little Kimble cum Marsh neighbourhood Plan

I would like to make three comments on the above document.

1. Land at Grove Lane (West) (ref no 1) - this site has a large pond at the rear and as the plan mentions protection of existing biodiversity assets I hope that this site is re-visited before any planning permission is given. During this wet winter the footway and part of the road has had running water at times due either to the pond overflowing or the water table rising. Any works needed to stop this must surely be detrimental to the habitat.
2. Land at The Laurels, Marsh Road (Ref no 10). This road is very narrow in parts and without substantial work will cause problems with the extra traffic.
3. Lastly - traffic calming has been mentioned under local infrastructure improvements along Bridge Street and Church Lane. It is true that some drivers do drive at what feels like speeding if you are a pedestrian but is unlikely to be above 30mph. The extra traffic from the school is a bit of a problem at times and since the road was re-surfaced people just drive straight down the middle of the road. All the residents should be consulted on any works and at least 60% should agree to it. Yes I live in Bridge Street and so I have a vested interest. I have spoken to a number of residents who all agreed speed bumps is the last thing we want to solve a problem that is not really a problem.
