

# Great and Little Kimble cum Marsh Neighbourhood Plan Referendum

## Information Statement

A referendum relating to the adoption of the Great and Little Kimble cum Marsh Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 6 May 2021

The question that will be asked in the referendum is as follows:

**“Do you want Buckinghamshire Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Great and Little Kimble cum Marsh to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”**

The referendum area is identical to the area that has been designated as the Great and Little Kimble cum Marsh Neighbourhood area. Please find map below.

### • **Can I Vote?**

- You can vote in the referendum if you live in the parish of Great and Little Kimble cum Marsh and;
- You are registered to vote in local council elections, and
- You are 18 years of age or over on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2021
- You have to be registered to vote by 19 April 2021 to vote in the referendum. You can check if you are registered to vote by calling 01296 798141 or emailing [elections@buckinghamshire.gov.uk](mailto:elections@buckinghamshire.gov.uk)

The expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2,362 + (876 x £0.059) = **£2413.68**

The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 876

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures similar to those used at local government elections.
