With regard to the Wycombe local plan for development.

I would like to register my objection to the proposed development at High Heavens in Marlow Bottom

This land was the garden owned by Mrs Margaret Beer who used it to look after injured owls given to her by local residents. In her will she left this land to a local animal charity to continue her work. They subsequently went against her wishes and they sold it to developers.

Marlow Bottom as you may be aware has been over developed over the past 20 years, and consequently the infra structure is totally overloaded.

The road running through the village is very narrow and where cars park in the road stop two way traffic flow. To cater for the 1200+ houses/families in the village the entrance to the village gets totally jammed at times causing vehicles to take up to twenty minutes just to get out of the valley.
