### **Proposed Main Modifications to the Wycombe District Local Plan**

Thank you for your e-mail advising Historic England of the consultation on the Proposed Main Modifications to the Wycombe District Local Plan. We are pleased the following comments.

**PMM2** – Historic England welcomes and supports the proposed main modifications to paragraph 2.1.

**PMM10** – Historic England welcomes and supports the proposed main modifications to Policy CP11 and paragraph 4.118.

**PMM17** – Historic England welcomes and supports, in principle, the proposed main modifications to paragraph 5.1.71, but “Registered Historic Landscape” should be Registered Historic Park and Garden”.

**PMM43** – Historic England welcomes and supports the proposed main modifications to Policy BE2.

**PMM64** – Historic England welcomes and supports the proposed main modifications to Policy DM31 and paragraph 6.112, although we regret the non-inclusion of any explanation in the policy that non-designated assets of archaeological interest of demonstrably equivalent significance to scheduled monuments should be considered subject to the policies for designated heritage assets, as set out in footnote 63 of the National Planning Policy Framework, as we suggested to the Council.

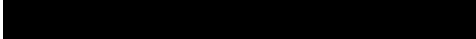
