### What are we consulting on?

Wycombe District Council is holding a consultation on behalf of the Planning Inspector on the Proposed Main Modifications to the Wycombe District Local Plan (submission version):

I am writing to you because you are either a Duty to Cooperate Body, a Specific Consultee or General Consultee, or you are on our Planning Consultation database, having responded to previous consultation stages.

### Background

The Council submitted the Wycombe District Local Plan for examination in public in March 2018. The independent Local Plan Inspector held hearings over the summer of 2018.

The Inspector has identified various changes that she considers may need to be made to the Plan (known as "Proposed Main Modifications") in order to make the Wycombe District Local Plan a "sound"

plan. We invite your comments, also known as representations, on these Proposed Main Modifications. We will send these representations to the Inspector for consideration in the preparation of her final report on the examination of the Plan.

The Proposed Main Modifications document is accompanied by:

- a revised Sustainability Appraisal
- a revised Habitats Regulations Assessment
- a Sustainability Appraisal of the Proposed Main Modifications
- a Habitats Regulations Assessment of the Proposed Main Modifications

Please clearly state which Proposed Main Modification number or numbers your response relates to (for example, PMM1, PMM2 and so on).

Comments will only be accepted for the Proposed Main Modifications. General comments about the content of the Local Plan not related to a Proposed Main Modification will not be accepted.

### **Next Steps**

We will pass all representations received to the independent Local Plan Inspector for consideration. Once the Inspector has reviewed the representations she will advise the Council about how she wishes to proceed with the Examination. Should the Inspector decide that no additional Hearing Sessions are necessary then she will advise the Council of the likely date of submission of her report of findings. Once the inspector's report is published, this will set out any changes that are necessary to make the Wycombe District Local Plan sound. The Council must accept those changes if it wishes to adopt the Local Plan. We anticipate the Council will consider this in the summer of 2019.
