Adoption Statement – 16th July 2013

Wycombe District Council Delivery and Site Allocations Plan for Town Centres and Managing Development - Notice of Adoption Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) - Section 23 The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 - Regulations 17, 26 and 35

This statement gives notice that Wycombe District Council adopted the Delivery and Site Allocations Plan for Town Centres and Managing Development on 16th July 2013.

The Delivery and Site Allocations Plan includes allocations for new development and change in the main town centres and development management policies to secure sustainable development across the District.

A Secretary of State appointed independent Planning Inspector has concluded in his report that the Delivery and Site Allocations Plan is sound subject to recommended main modifications. These modifications are set out in an appendix to the Inspector's report and constitute modifications made pursuant to Section 23(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended). The Delivery and Site Allocations Plan includes all of these modifications and has been adopted in accordance with Section 23 of the Act

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Wycombe District Council Delivery and Site Allocations Plan for Town Centres and Managing Development may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) on the grounds that:

- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

An application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than the end of the period of six weeks, which commenced on 16th July 2013 and concludes on 27th August 2013.
