Adoption Statement: Householder Planning and Design Guidance Supplementary Planning Document

Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

Wycombe District Council formally adopted the Householder Planning and Design Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 15 January 2020.

The Householder Planning and Design Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) provides design guidance to householders on principles of good design. It sits alongside policies DM35: Placemaking and Design Quality and DM36: Extensions and Alterations to Existing Dwellings of the Wycombe District Local Plan.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision, and any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
