I have received the new Princes Risborough Expansion Plan.

I have walked the fields where the expansion will be carried out especially in the area which will be the Green Corridor and the Alscot Conservation Area.

I was under the impression that the Alscot Conservation Area had been expanded in recent years to take into account one of the fields but I cannot see this on the plan so I would like to know if this has changed again as the Conservation Area is shown as it used to be.

I am also worried about the type of housing that will be built alongside the Green Corridor and the Conservation Area. On the original plans in the local plan it show against these areas but the new Princes Risborough Expansion leaflet seems to have reversed that and put the lower density housing against the railway line and the Risborough Town Character housing up against the Green Corridor and Conservation Area..
