Dear Council members

I would like to give my views on the Proposed Princes Risborough Expansion.

Firstly I do not believe Princes Risborough is the right place for an expansion of the scale proposed – clearly the fact that the houses already built are not selling reflects this .

The town has not got the facilities to cope with the numbers planned which means that if these are not going to be added to until nearing the end of the proposed development people will have to drive to Wycombe or Aylesbury thus increasing congestion on overused roads.

There is no infrastructure planned for the increased traffic into Wycombe through West Wycombe .

Shootacre Lane and Picts Lane were found 2 years ago to be unsuitable for use as a relief road – they are not suitable as a temporary relief road !

They form part of the Pheonix trail and the Ridgeway which is a National Bridleway.

They are an important amenity used by both local people and tourists.

To try to route HGV's up these lanes is hazardous and temporary widening measures as well as being a waste of council payers money will only increase the ability of traffic to speed and make these lanes dangerous for cyclists, walkers and horses .

I believe the expansion of Princes Risborough which is a small Market town should be considerably smaller in keeping with its present size.
