PRINCES ROSSBOROUGH BYPASS - PICTS LANE/SHOOTACRE LANE

I am appalled, worried and upset by the decision to consider that the bypass be routed along Shootacre and Picts Lane.

I live at [REDACTED] PICTS LANE at the junction with Shootacre Lane, and have lived here for nearly 60 yrs.

Your proposal to widen this junction to accommodate heavy and frequent traffic is unbelievable and impractical. Only recently my fence was seriously damaged by a car (7 fence panels and 8 posts removed), and over the years I have incurred similar damage due to the narrowness of the road.

Bearing in mind that there is no footpath, and none proposed, how are pedestrians supposed to walk in safety? Many cyclists use this road to reach the Cycle Route 57, also horse riders.

How will cars, which need to reverse out of driveways, even get out onto a busy road?

Why spend £376k on a "temporary" bypass? Please reconsider the "Cowerton Link" - Shootacre and Picts Lane are special.

I would appeal to you not to consider the Shootacre/Picts Lane route - and please do not consign my letter to 'copy and paste'. Our views must be seriously considered.
