



ADOPTION STATEMENT – 16 March 2021

Princes Risborough Expansion Supplementary Planning Document

The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

In accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council adopted the Princes Risborough Expansion Supplementary Planning Document on 16 March 2021.

This document was prepared to support the implementation of policies in the Wycombe District Local Plan adopted 2019. It sets out more detail about how these policies should be delivered. In doing so it provides a framework to help guide the preparation and assessment of future planning applications within the expansion area.

Due to Covid 19 - Regulations 35 and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), have been temporarily amended and the council is no longer required to:

- make available for inspection, the supplementary planning document at its principal office and at such other places within its area as the local planning authority consider appropriate, during normal office hours; or
- provide a copy of the document.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
