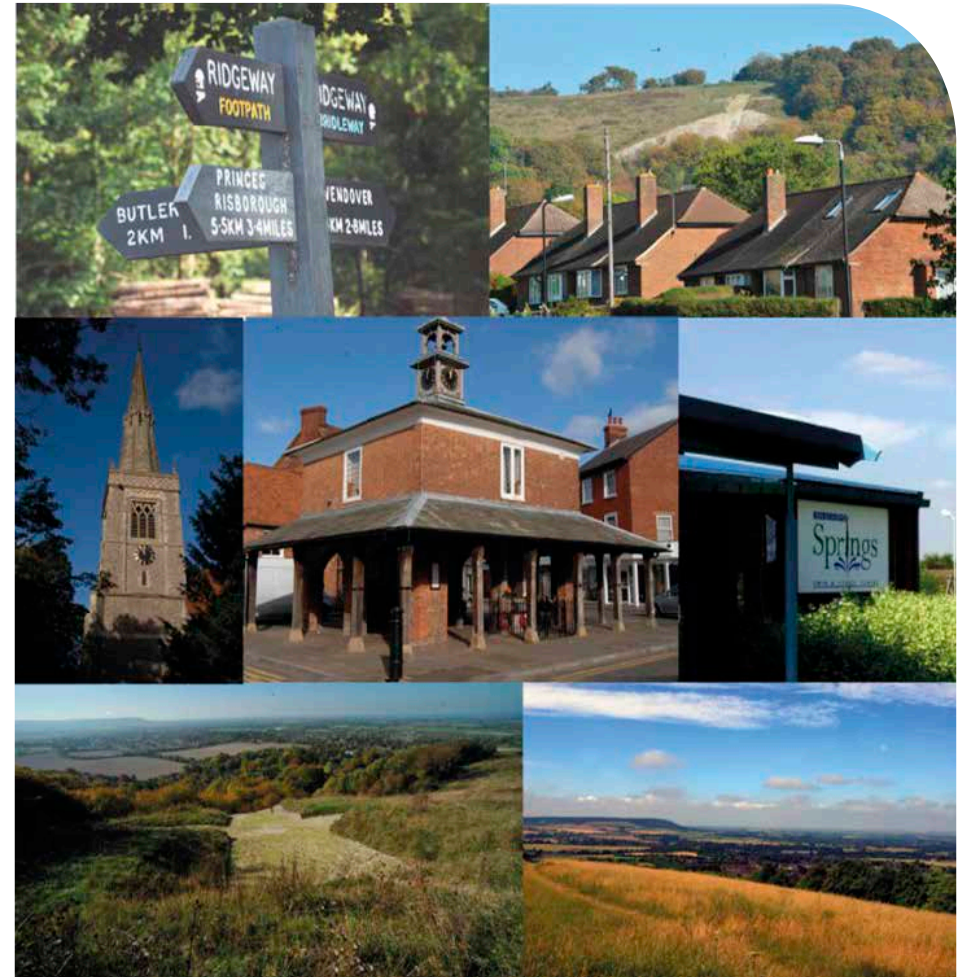

Please comment on the future of your town

From 15 February to 28 March, we are asking local people to comment on a draft plan for the expansion of Princes Risborough which will change the town. We want to give you the opportunity to help us to refine our draft plan. If you want to find out more, come and meet us at one of these events.

There's a shortage of homes both nationally and locally and right now, Princes Risborough, like many towns and villages all over the country, is facing the challenge of piecemeal development.

But building more homes isn't enough on its own, because without putting in roads, schools, public transport, open spaces and sports facilities for people to enjoy, you aren't putting in the infrastructure needed to support the people who live in the town.

Together we need to find the right local solution for the future of Princes Risborough. Over the last couple of years we've run a series of local meetings and exhibitions and right from the beginning, both our organisations – Princes Risborough Town Council and Wycombe District Council – have been working very closely together.

We established a local steering group – chaired by Princes Risborough Town Council – which includes representatives from a wide range of groups in the town. By listening to the feedback we've had from public exhibitions and workshops and testing the technical evidence we've shaped a bespoke draft town plan for Princes Risborough.

Even if we do not plan for this expansion, the town will grow over the next decade or so. At the time of writing, there are a number of development applications, some at appeal, some pending decision. Without a robust plan in place we have no real power to ensure that we are in control of that growth. Over the last two years we have reluctantly had to accept that the choice is not between growth and no growth, but between planned growth and unplanned growth. This is your chance to help us plan for that growth. We welcome your thoughts and opinions.
